

**TRANSPORT FOR IMPINGTON VILLAGE COLLEGE
SIXTH FORM STUDENTS
via CAMBRIDGE REGIONAL COLLEGE**

We have an arrangement with CRC whereby students studying at Impington for either the *International Baccalaureate* or 'A' Level *Performing Arts*, neither of which is offered by CRC, may use the bus service operated by CRC. This brings students in from a wide catchment area, terminating at the CRC King's Hedges Campus from where we provide a minibus to bring students on to Impington. The shuttle also operates at the end of the college day when it returns students to King's Hedges to connect with home going transport. CRC charge for the use of their transport and we makes a small charge for the use of the minibus.

A list of current routes is shown is attached.

- **Some differences exist between term dates for CRC and Impington Village College for which you will need to arrange alternative transport. CRC operate services during term times from Monday 4 September 2006 until Friday 28 June 2007.**

All bus routes terminate at CRC's King's Hedges campus. A minibus is provided for our students between CRC and IVC, departing King's Hedges at approx 08.45 each morning and leaving IVC at 15.45 to connect with home going transport. Transport leaves CRC at 16.40 each day.

However, it should be noted that commitment to use this transport is on an annual and not termly basis. Payment from students is therefore required for the full year, regardless of the actual usage in each term.

Please note that transport arrangements and costs are reviewed annually and are subject to change.
